Can volunteers serve before completing all application requirements?

Volunteers are allowed to serve one time in our Meal Ministry before completing all volunteer application requirements.

What is the minimum age requirement to serve?

Anyone 13 years or older can serve as a volunteer. Anyone 18 years or older can serve as a high impact volunteer.

What are volunteers required to wear while serving?

We recommend blue jeans or cargo pants, t-shirts or long-sleeved shirts, jackets, sweatshirts, closed-toe shoes like sneakers, tennis shoes, or work boots. Hair is required to be pulled back into a ponytail if serving in Meal Ministry.

Is there parking available at all our locations?

Yes! There are parking lots available at our Voeghtly Street Shelter and Ridge Recovery Place directly next to the buildings. There is a parking lot and free street parking available outside our Food Pantry.





When are there volunteer opportunties at the Mission?

There are a variety of times available to volunteer to fit your schedule. We offer volunteer opportunties every day of the week, including weekends! There are day and evening shifts.
